

We would like to congratulate the newest PhD graduate on our board, Mads, on his successful PhD defense on 10 September 2024!

Mads defended his dissertation, titled *Inequalities in early* life mortality. Exploring sex, social class and place as risk factors in death in nineteenth and early twentieth-century Denmark opposite opponents Morten Rasmussen (University of Copenhagen), Isabelle Devos (Ghent University), and Bo Poulsen (Aalborg University).

Mads will continue researching mortality in Denmark as a postdoc at the PandemiX Center at Roskilde University.
